Fahaheel Al-Watanieh Indian Private School conducted its FAIPS MODEL UNITED NATIONS-2023 on the 6th & 7th of September, thereby, continuing with its exceptional array of extracurricular activities

The two-day Inter- house Competition began with a gleaming inaugural ceremony in the presence of the Principal, Vice-Principals, Headmistress, Senior Mistress and the participating delegates belonging to the six houses. The session began with the official opening by SG Johan Varghese Sajan, and was held over 2 days of compelling debate, discussion and deliberation, amongst 5 committees, and 84 delegates.
