Nica – My Lovely Pet


Nica my tiny cat, With fur that's soft and grey, She likes to nap on cozy mats, And in the sun she'll lay.


I started origami when I was four. I started with simple things like boats and aeroplanes. Now, I can make complex things like a Frisbee, batarang, dragons, and birds.
