The committee of the International Atomic Energy Agency, with Shubhangi Sharma as the Director, was been set up to discuss the topic Nuclear Disaster Prevention and Response in which nuclear disasters were discussed, where countries talked about the intricacies of nuclear disaster prevention and response, making sure that governments and companies take responsibility and provide a quick and efficient response system and also about the implementation of a preventions system for these disasters.

The agenda of The United Nations Security Council was 'Assessing and Minimizing the usage of Biochemical weapons' with Aryan Nair as the Director. Delegates took charge exceedingly early on during committee and continued to raise motions to further solve this vast topic. Throughout the course of the committee sessions, the delegates were faced with a variety of crises that often challenged their stances and forced them to approach committee in a new way. A resolution was agreed upon during committee and was successfully passed.
