The students of FAIPS have once again proved their academic excellence by their scintillating performance in different Olympiads held by the Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF) for the year 2018-2019, namely, International Mathematics Olympiad (IMO) and National Science Olympiad (NSO), ANCQ (Chemistry quiz) and National Astronomy and Science Olympiad (NASO).

Siddhangana Sinha secured the top position in the International Mathematics Olympiad held in November 2018 at FAIPS, securing a medal of distinction. She qualified for the second level held in February 2019 and received a zonal certificate for the same. Archisha Pal, was presented with a gold medal and a participation certificate. The silver medal was awarded to Rohit Vinod and the bronze medal to Shad Ahmed.
