Subject: Provisional Affiliation & Upgradation of Fahaheel
Al Watanih Indian Private School, Ahmadi - Kuwait.

Kind attention - Mr.B.P. Khandelwal, Chairman, CBSE, New Delhi.

Dear Shri Khandelwal,

This is in continuation to our earlier letter No.KUW/ISI/321/5/95(P&M) dated 20th November, 1995 forwarding application No.4378 to Shri S.C. Gupta, Secretary, Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, on the above cited subject.

2. It is strongly recommended that **Fahaheel Al Watanih Indian Private School** which is established by the **Al Nouri Teaching Establishment, Kuwait**, in collaboration with the **Delhi Public School Society, New Delhi, India**, may kindly be granted affiliation and permission in principle to start class XI in the next academic session starting from 1st April, 1996 since there is a big demand and on the following grounds:-

- i) Reference to the recent decision of the department of Private Education, Ministry of Education of Kuwait to discontinue second shift (afternoon shift) in all schools including the Indian Schools. The Indian community is facing a serious problem of education of their wards in Senior Secondary classes due to the paucity of seats in good schools having the infrastructural facilities of well equipped laboratories and library etc;
- ii) If this population is not captured, there is a strong possibility that it may join other Boards of education such as 'A' level, 'O' level, Baccullarate, or else. Their inconvenience may lead them to move to India for admission and thereby causing burden on already overcrowded schools.

3. Since this school (established by the Al Nouri Teaching Establishment of Kuwait in collaboration with the Delhi Public School Society) is well equipped and have not only the basic infrastructural facilities in terms of laboratories and library etc., it is having highly qualified and experienced teachers from the Delhi Public School, R.K. Puram, New Delhi, which constitutes the teaching faculty of this school, Indian community parents are demanding to secure admission for their children at +2 level and thereby getting the benefit of education at the hands of the seasoned teachers from the reputed institutions of the Delhi Public School Society as stated above.

4. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that affiliation and permission to start class XI in the session 1996-97, may kindly be granted, subject to your formal inspection for the first provisional affiliation

and upgradation at your earliest convenient date.
